The Elmsdale (Exit 8, Hwy 102) and Enfield (Exit 7, Hwy 102) area is minutes from the Halifax International Airport (Exit 6, Hwy 102) and features some unique attractions as well as a full range of **shops and services**.

Appropriately located near the airport is the **Atlantic Canada Aviation Museum**. The museum has a comprehensive collection of artifacts and exhibits depicting Atlantic Canada's aviation history including photos, uniforms, medals, aircraft engines, bombs and rockets, a Link trainer and the Argus long-range patrol aircraft simulator!

Just down the road from the museum is **Scotia Speedworld**, Eastern Canada's premiere stock car racing facility. From the comfortable seating of the

outdoor grandstand, visitors can quench their thirst for speed at exciting weekly **stock car racing** events.

For a quick round of **golf**, a Nine Mile River campground has a fun nine-hole course, complete with 18-hole **mini-golf**. Visit the community of Ardoise and enjoy **horseback riding** year round in the beautiful countryside at Boulderwood Stables. Also, discover the nearby **Uniacke Estate Museum Park** (Exit 3 off Hwy 101). This Country Estate built in 1813-15 was the property of Attorney General Richard John Uniacke. With it's original furnishings it is one of Canada's finest examples of a grand country house in the Georgian Tradition.
