The Letters H, M, L, in the above columns are for the periods of HIGH or MEDIUM or LOW Tidal Bores. The High Tidal Bores are from 10 to 18 Inches High, 25 to 46 cm. The Medium Tidal Bores are from 6 to 10 Inches High, 15 to 25 cm. The Low Tidal Bores are from 0 to 6 Inches High, 0 to 15 cm.

The Tidal Bore can be up to 20 Minutes Earlier or Later than the above times.

In Maccan from Rt # 302 take Rt # 242 at Phil's Auto Body Shop, cross the railroad then quickly turn right on the gravel road across the marsh to the parking area at the river.

The Bore comes from the right around the curve and past the park.

The High and Medium Bores can be seen good coming around the curve.

The Low Bores are best viewed from the dyke to the left of the parking lot.

The heavy rush of water that occurs up to 30 minutes after the bore is great to watch as the currents and waves keep changing as the water flows faster.

During the High Tides the river will fill full in 1 hr. 45 min. and raise about 17 feet or 5.18 Meters and on the Low Tides the river only fills half full in 1 hr. 30 min. to about 8 feet or 2.4 Meters.

The Tidal Bore can be seen from the River Hebert Highway Bridge 20 minutes before the Maccan Bore Times.

The Great Heights of the Bay of Fundy tides can be seen at Joggins, 34 to 45 feet and at Parrsboro, 36 to 48 feet.

This Maccan Tidal View Wetland Park is on Ducks Unlimited Land and was built and opened in 1998 by the efforts of Ducks Unlimited and some members of the Maccan Royal Canadian Legion.

From the Dyke one can view the water ponds for ducks and other birds on the marsh and there are other ponds in the woods near the railroad.

There are also other Ducks Unlimited Wetlands in the Maccan area.
